During the nineties the scope of operations was further supplemented with the inclusion of Lifting equipment inspection, test and repair services to the hydrocarbons industry.

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INSPECTION PERSONNEL

AMOSCO Tubular (O. C. T. G.) Equipment Inspectors

Policy:

All Tubular Inspectors are trained and certified to ASNT Level II (M P I & L P I), they work to API specification applying the relevant specification to each and every work to be performed.

American Society of Non-Destructive Testing (ASNT):

AMOSCO is a member of ASNT and has adopted its policies as well as standards on tubular inspections. AMOSCO also offers inspections as per DS1 standards within its scope of operation.

Qualifications:

Beside the above mentioned qualifications, all personnel authorised to undertake or directly supervise any inspection and reporting on tubular goods / equipment items on behalf of AMOSCO are trained and independently assessed.

AMOSCO Lifting Equipment Inspectors

Policy:

All personnel authorised to undertake or directly supervise the inspection; reporting and certification of lifting equipment items on behalf of AMOSCO are trained and independently assessed by the Lifting Equipment Engineers Association (L.E.E.A.) of the UK or equivalent well known Establishments and / or associations such as City & Guilds.

Lifting Equipment Engineers Association (L.E.E.A.):

AMOSCO is a member of the L.E.E.A. and has adopted the Code of Practice of this organisation as a basis for all Standard Operating Procedures relating to the certification of Lifting Equipment within AMOSCO's scope of operation.

Qualifications:

Inspection personnel undergo technical training provided both by the L.E.E.A. and internally by AMOSCO. Inspectors are independently assessed and qualified by the L.E.E.A. in relation to Lifting Equipment Inspection, and by A.S.N.T in relation to NDT requirements. Inspectors are trained in M.P.I, L.P.T and Eddy Current techniques of N.D.T.

Technical Support:

AMOSCO operates a technical support facility for its Clients and operating Inspectors. The support is provided by Structural, Mechanical and Crane Engineers experienced in the requirements of the offshore Hydrocarbons Industry. Support is offered as bespoke design services, procedure, specifications and training development for AMOSCO Clients and AMOSCO Inspection personnel.
